MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

All individuals who are honorably discharged from any branch of the United States Armed Services are eligible to join. Submission of an application and a copy of your Certificate of Honorable Discharge, Retirement Certificate or a copy of your DD-214 (please redact all personal information, i.e. your Social Security Number and the names and addresses of your next of kin that might be listed). **There is no application fee.**

All required uniform items, except footwear and collar devices, are issued free to a new member after attendance of three consecutive meetings.

All members are required to participate in one meeting and one formal ceremony within every sixty (60) days. Two meetings are held each month at 0900 (2nd and 4th Monday at Saddlebrook Recreation Center). There are ten (10) Ceremonies at the Memorial Park each year and one (1) at Fire Station 44 on September 11. Some may preempt the other. During the month of August and some holidays, members may be exempt from attending meetings.

All hardship cases, planned vacations, sickness and other personal matters, need to be communicated to the Commander or Vice Commander.
